<p>West Bromwich Albion FC Study Support Centre has a nationally recognised and unique partnership with West Bromwich Albion FC's Community Programme.</p> <p>Many programmes are run in collaboration and clearly demonstrate the links between physical activity and attainment.</p> <p>Examples of successful partnership work are;</p> <p>The extremely popular "90 Minutes Club" which delivers 45 minutes of education, followed by 45 minutes of multi-sports, with coaches and mentors supporting both sessions. These sessions help to raise standards and promote physical activity.</p> <p>3D is a community-led programme that provides 25 hours/week of multi-sport, mentoring and life-skills for permanently excluded young people. WBA FC Study Support staff deliver ICT based alternative education sessions to assist with the reintegration of students back into school.</p> <p>Other joint programmes include; breakfast, lunchtime and after school clubs and PPA (Planning, Preparation and Assessment) cover in schools.</p> <p>In addition to our collaborative programmes Study Support staff and Community Programme staff also share office space, training sessions and resources. This ensures a close working relationship between all staff.</p> <p>Working together has many benefits to Study Support, The Community Programme, schools, families and pupils. Crucially, impact can be maximised and "Every Child Matters" outcomes can be creatively achieved and effectively measured.</p>
